



SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Native Village of Nuiqsut (NVN) offers a scholarship grant for students seeking financial assistance for higher education student expenses.

These scholarship grants are designed for students who are graduating from high school and are enrolled or accepted for enrollment in a degree-granting program of an accredited college or university and have definite financial needs after other sources of funds are applied.

Students receiving a scholarship must maintain acceptable academic standing at their institution of higher education, they must maintain acceptable social conduct within the policies and rules of the institution attending, must demonstrate satisfactory progress toward degree requirements, and must submit a written application for funding in accordance with NVN's established deadlines:

<i>Deadline for scholarship for high school graduate:</i>	<i>April 30</i>
<i>Deadline for Fall Semester:</i>	<i>August 30</i>
<i>Deadline for Spring Semester:</i>	<i>December 30</i>

A scholarship grant is not an individual right and NVN may approve and may deny funding in accordance with its policies.

The Native Village of Nuiqsut will ensure that counseling and guidance services are available to assist students in preparing for college; to assist with the financial aid application process; and to assist in the following up on students' social and academic progress.

The Native Village of Nuiqsut will have a file of current state college catalogs maintained where they are accessible to students.

Funds are limited and released only by approval of the NVN Village Council at a duly called meeting and no student is funded who does not meet the eligibility criteria.
